

Safety Protocols at Mary, Queen of Peace Church (as of 11/16/2020)

Before coming to Mary, Queen of Peace Church, please do this self-assessment:

- In the last 14 days, have I or someone I have close contact with...
 - ...traveled internationally?
 - ...been exposed to a person with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 without the correct personal protection?
 - ...had a temperature of 100.4°F or greater?
 - ...had a new or increased shortness of breath or difficulty breathing?
 - ...had a new cough?
 - ...had at least two of the following symptoms together: chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, vomiting, runny nose/congestion, fatigue?

If you or someone you have close contact with answer “yes” to any of these questions, please contact your health care provider, and also take care of yourself and others by staying home and not coming to MQP in person. Please connect with us through our opportunities for live-streaming.

While at Mary, Queen of Peace Church:

- A face covering must be worn at all times in the church, plaza, and parking lot.
 - If you are not able to wear a face covering, please contact us and we will work with you to try to make an accommodation to allow you to attend safely.
- Maintain at least 6-foot distance between you and members of other households at all times.
- Hand sanitizer is available in the hallways, and soap and water are available in the restrooms.
 - Two people maximum at a time in the restrooms.

Please know...

...staff and volunteers are working very hard to provide the safest environment we can. However, there is still a risk in coming to MQP. This risk could be increased for someone over 60 years of age or someone with underlying health conditions. Please carefully consider the risks involved, and make the decision that is best for the health and safety of you and your loved ones.
